You must be a registered youth or young adult observer to participate in any of the All-American Council's youth and young adult activities

General Policies

Alcohol and other drugs are prohibited from any youth activity or area used for youth activities, regardless of age.

Youth Observers are to be in Youth Activity areas only when two adults over the age of 21 are present.

Any failure to obey these or other policies outlined at orientation will jeopardize a youth observer's ability to participate in the Council's youth activities.

Parents and/or chaperones are responsible for youth observers at any time they are not signed into one of the Church's youth activities.

Important Information

T-shirts, name badges and wrist bands are provided to youth as an extra security measure to help identify them. They must be worn daily. No exceptions.

Times noted on the schedule are sign in/sign out times. Parents are asked to drop off and pick up their children promptly at designated times.

Parents/chaperones must sign-in and sign-out pre-teens for all sessions/activities in the rooms noted at the top of the schedule on the reverse side.

Teens may sign themselves in and out at the rooms noted on the schedule on the reverse side. They are, however, expected to stay for the entire activity and will not be dismissed before a given activity has ended.

Youth observers will be signed in once at the beginning of the day and then signed out at the conclusion of the day's activities according to the times noted on the youth schedule.

There will be no "police" making sure that every youth observer is at every activity. Sign in/out sheets will be posted at the youth booth the next day for parents to check.

All youth observers ages 7-17(18) will be assigned to a specific group on Monday for activity purposes and identified with a wrist band. The wrist band must not be removed. Once assigned to a group, the youth will remain in that group. This ensures the safety of all youth observers.

The youth will also be assigned to ride a bus for activities away from the hotel. Once assigned, the youth must ride the designated bus. He/she may not change ID bracelets, badges, groups, or buses.

Participants are discouraged from bringing personal items, other than snacks and spending money, to any session or excursion. The AAC and its staff and chaperones are not responsible for lost or misplaced items.

Parents attending outings: While parents may elect to go to a location their child is going to as part of the Council's activities, the child will remain with his/her assigned group and will be transported to and from the event by transportation provided by the AAC. This transportation is for the sole use of the youth observers and staff/chaperones. Parents are responsible for paying their own admission and are not eligible for the group rate. Most outings may be reached by using the I-Drive trolley service across from the hotel.

Lifeguards will only be provided on Thursday as indicated on the schedule. At all other times youth are the responsibility of their parent/temporary guardian and swim at their own risk.

Meal/Food Tips:

The All-American Council's Youth and Young Adult Activities include meals and snacks as noted under Daily Schedule Notes.

The continental breakfast each day is only open to youth observers who present their wristband.

Parents are encouraged to provide participants with pocket money for souvenirs, drinks, etc. during excursions outside the hotel.

Please bring a filled water bottle daily in the backpack provided.

Important Reminders for each day

Monday-Don't forget to wear your AAC t-shirt and badge. Bring a filled water bottle. Lunch and snack provided. Sign-in at 10:00 a.m.; pick-up at 5:00 p.m.

Tuesday—Wear t-shirt, badge and wristband. Wear bathing suit under clothing. Bring towel, sunscreen (SPF 15 at minimum), hats, sport drink, water bottle, pocket money, afternoon snack. Lunch, dinner and snack provided. Personal flotation devices (PFDs/life vests) are not allowed in the park unless certified. Sign-in 9:00 a.m.; pick-up 10:00 p.m.

Wednesday—Wear t-shirt, badge and wristband. Bring sunscreen (SPF15 at minimum), hat, sport drink, filled water bottle, pocket money, and snacks if desired. Lunch and snack provided. Sign in at 9:00 a.m.; pick up at 6:30 p.m.

Thursday—Wear swimsuit under clothing. Wear tshirt and wristband. Bring towel, sunscreen, sport drink, filled water bottle, pocket money, and snack if desired. Lunch, dinner, and snack are provided. Also, pack a complete change of clothes (AAC tshirt and shorts/pants) and a plastic bag for wet swim suits.

Sign-in 10:30 a.m.; pick-up 10:30 p.m. (Yes, 12 hours of fun.)

Youth observers will come to Vespers withYouth staff/chaperones and depart for Fun Spot directly from the service. Youth will remain with their assigned group during Vespers.

Friday—Free dress day. Sign in 9:00 am.; pick up at noon.

Monday-Friday: A playgroup room (Walu meeting room) is open for use from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. to parents with young children. Activities will focus around the theme "The House that God Built." Children must be supervised by parent/guardian.
