The Canonization Commission studies individuals being considered for glorification by the Orthodox Church in America according to the following criteria, universally established throughout the Orthodox Church worldwide:


- Popular Veneration

- Spiritual Impact on the Church


Not all of these criteria are absolute prerequisites in every case of glorification by the Church.

Decision in the Minutes of the Holy Synod - Fall 2008
