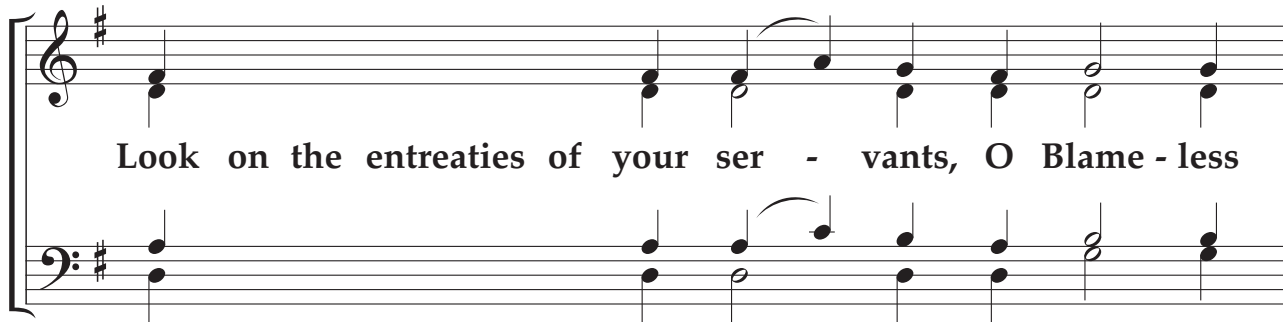
Like the Prodigal Son, I too— have re-turned af - ter

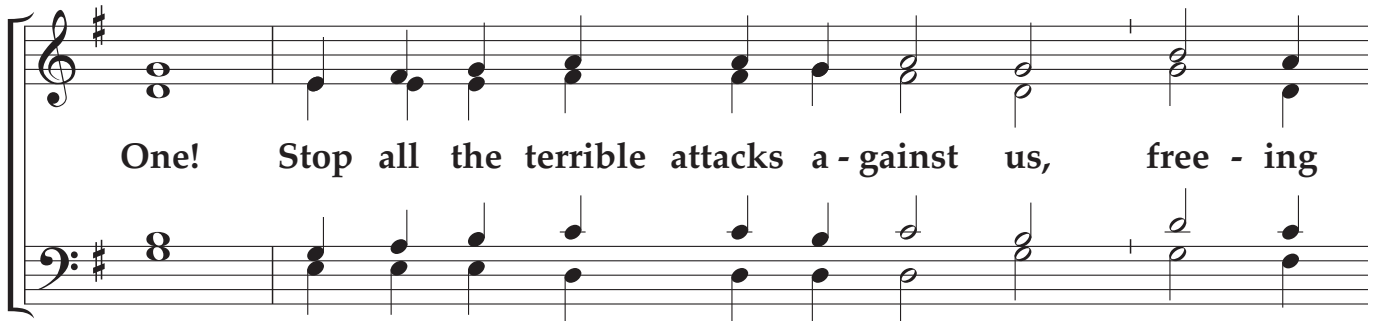

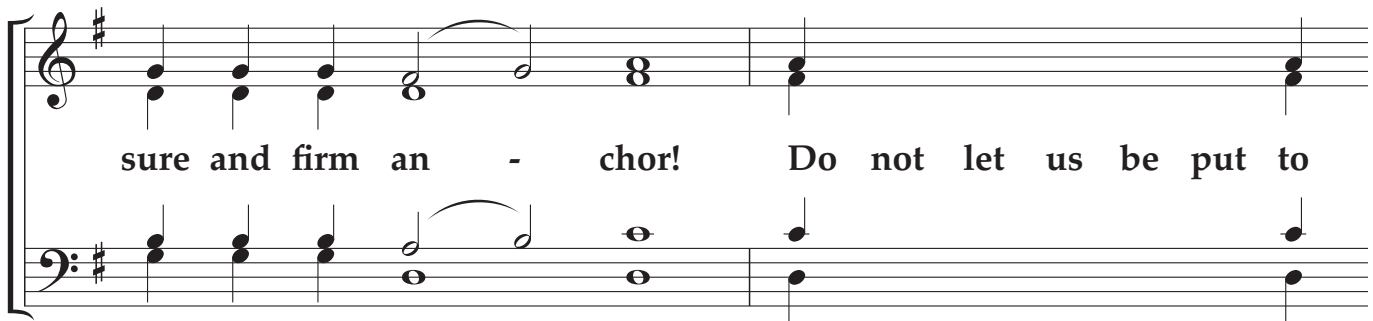
