The grace of God, the grace of God has ap -

peared for the sal - va - tion of all men.

Accidentals in parentheses are optional, indicating varied performance practice.

*The above may be sung as a refrain with verses from the same chapter of Titus, or with verses of Psalm 97 [98].
At the end we sing:*

Al - le - lu - i - a, al - le -

lu - i - a, al - le - lu - i - a.

While the conclusion of this koinonikon is commonly sung as above, in this tone, Byzantine chant traditionally calls for the final syllable to conclude on A. Accordingly, if desired, the final B may be omitted, and the A held as a dotted whole note. The ison remains on E.
