

NOTE: This sequence of refrains corresponds to an ode of the Kanon, and is repeated accordingly. The heirmoi of the Canon are typically not sung. After the 3rd and 6th ode (or their refrains), the following Katavasia is sung:

If a full Moleben is sung:

After the 3rd Ode: Abbreviated Augmented Litany

After the 6th Ode: Little Litany, Prokeimenon, and Gospel.

After the 9th Ode: In place of the Katavasia, "It is truly meet" or, during a feast, the appropriate Festal Hymn to the Theotokos.











Verse 1 (Ps. 39:1)
