For only You can be all-merciful and save me, O God, and to You I give glory: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

II. O God, the Father of Our Lord Jesus Christ! Your presence offers strength and the patience to endure all things. Relieve me in my distress. Sustain me when I feel hopeless and depressed. In my illness, bless and strengthen me, day by day. Guard me from impatience and irritability. May Your divine blessing fill every means necessary for my recovery. Grant me the ability and the desire to cooperate with You and with those caring for me. Grant that faith and hope may be so strengthened and confirmed that I may never openly

complain or murmur. Fill me with Your Light, that with the eye of faith I may see beyond my illness and, in remembrance of past blessings, be encouraged to hope for and accept the comfort You offer me.
